Bicolore gel coat standard: Ivory hull with marine blue stripes

All steel parts and screws only AISI 316L

Brass seacock under water line and chromed brass above

2 side doors portside and starboards side

stainless steel bathing ladder on transom

2 stainless steel rubbing stripes on transom edge

1 bow stainless steel rubbing stripe above waterline

1 stainless steel rubbing stripe under water line at bow

2 galvanised protection under keels, including zinc anodes (one galvanised protection if single engine version)

2 stainless steel rudder shafts (one galvanised protection if single engine version)

Iroko wood hull rubbing stripes on both sides of the hull

1 tunnel bowthruster 55kg with dedicated battery 110 amp, joystick at helm station
