Track with cars for mainsail luff

Stainless steel rod rigging

Nordic Mast carbon fibre park avenue boom with sail cover and lights below

Selden Rod kick vang

Furling, self tacking jib x 2 - Original North plus Sanders 2014 Fully battened mainsail x 2 - Original North plus Dart Sails 2016 3 x Spinnakers, 1 asymmetric, 2 x symmetrical (1 large, 1 small) Spinnaker Pole stowed on deck

Tricolour light at masthead

Anchor light at masthead

Steaming light and deck light

## **Hull, deck and cockpit**

Hand laid teak on deck, coach roof and cockpit

Insulated hull laminated with hand lay up sandwich construction Fin keel with lead bulb

Epoxy treatment to hull at build

Aluminium toerail

Folding Sprayhood

Cockpit shelter from sprayhood to backstay (frameless bimini) Wheel steering with emergency tiller

Steering pedestal with stainless steel protection bar

Instrument pod and compass at helm

Sugar scoop transom, built in bathing platform

Transom opens for easy walk-through and stern boarding Folding cockpit table

Opening gates in guard rails, port and starboard

Opening pushpit and pulpit gates

Andersen self tailing, electric genoa winches

2 additional pairs of cockpit winches
